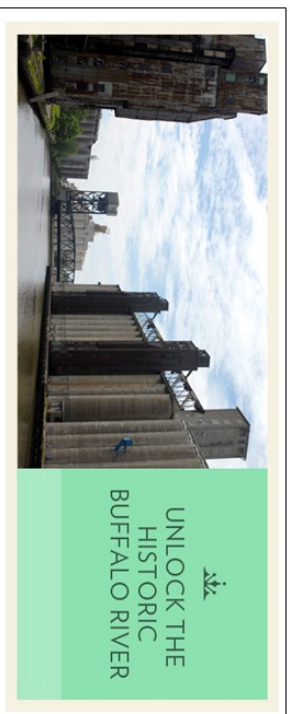
ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Basilica of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Victory ~ Buffalo River History Cruise ~ Group Dinner: Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach to New York State. As we travel rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later this morning arrive in Lackawanna and to the magnificent Basilica of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Victory. Constructed in 1921 as our nation's second oldest Basilica, Our Lady of Victory Church is built in elegant fourteenth and fifteenth-century Italian Renaissance style. The Basilica stands as a reflection of the life and work of Father Henry Baker who, through the intercession of Mary, saved thousands of orphaned and troubled boys and provided aid to multitudes of adults in hard economic times. We will enjoy a guided tour of the Basilica and then celebrate Mass. Time will also be provided for personal prayer, gift shop and museum on Father Baker. This afternoon we journey into downtown Buffalo and explore some of the historical sites which have made this a fascinating city. Embark on a cruise through history on this narrated Buffalo River History Tour! Hear the story of the Erie Canal, Buffalo's history as the largest grain port in the world and experience the nation's largest collection of standing grain elevators from just a few feet away. Later today we gather for dinner at a local restaurant before arriving at our hotel for the night.

Day 2: Niagara Falls State Park, NY ~ National Shrine Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima ~ Journey Home: Following breakfast at the hotel depart for Niagara Falls State Park, New York's oldest state park. Enjoy free time to explore the park which provides several observation areas overlooking the falls as well as numerous attractions, gift shops and restaurants. Niagara Falls has never ceased to be a natural wonder, mesmerizing travelers from around the world. Later today we arrive at the National Shrine Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima. Since 1954, Our Lady of Fatima Shrine has become a place of natural beauty, art, prayer and renewal to thousands who visit the shrine each year. The magnificence and natural beauty of the Shrine is highlighted by an awe-inspiring chapel whose semi-transparent dome depicts the Northern Hemisphere. Celebrate Mass in the chapel and then enjoy free time to walk the lovely grounds or visit the gift store. Later this afternoon we depart western New York and begin our journey home.
